



Construction complete: Fall 2014












An easy PATIENT EXPERIENCE

- for visitors and out-patients ensuring more intimacy for patients




Carefully planned AROUND THE PATIENT

500 individual patient rooms with private bathrooms, air conditioning and room for loved ones to stay the night




At the forefront of INNOVATION

The latest state-of-the art equipment, putting the Glen at the forefront of technology, thus helping reduce wait times for treatment

- 1 PET MRI (Magnetic resonance imaging) to better screen and diagnose cancer patients
- 7 MRIs, more than doubling the MUHC's imaging capacity
- 8 linear accelerators, including three specialty accelerators, allowing us to treat the most complex cancer cases

At the forefront of INNOVATION



Interventional platform

- Some of the most modern operating rooms in North America
- All 20 operating rooms and 21 intervention rooms will be clustered
- Increased efficiency and optimization of resources meaning faster and more effective care for patients
- Adjacent to key departments

At the forefront of INNOVATION



- **Two Emergency Departments: one** adult, one pediatric
- Can be expanded or contracted, like an accordion, to allow flexibility
- Separate patients from staff, creating privacy for patients
- 100% single-patient rooms, even in the emergency departments

Designed for GROUNDBREAKING RESEARCH



- The Centre for Innovative
 Medicine and the Centre for
 Translational Biology will be
 unique in Canada, helping
 move discoveries from the lab
 bench to the bedside
- Researchers will have an edge over the competition with direct access to clinicians and patients



Designed to be GREEN



- Four atria throughout the hospital complex
- Acres of green space, including a park, a children's playground, a zen garden and walking paths on site
- Will adhere to stringent environmental standards (LEED[®] Silver certification and BOMA BESt)




Accessing by car: FROM DECARIE


Access to the site via public transit: LINKS TO VENDÔME

The only hospital in Quebec to have a direct link to an intermodal station (metro, bus, train)


Accessing by BICYCLE and BY FOOT

- Bike racks and showers on site for employees who cycle to work




Access from the South: FROM THE SUD-OUEST




 Vehicle access for ambulances, employees and service vehicles
